 - Dr. Hayes from College of Education was interviewed by Lauren & Marci. They liked the proposed flow chart.
 - Dr. Reilly from the College of Engineering was interviewed by Lauren & Marci. They think the 3 reasons for a grade appeal should be listed with checkboxes. They would like the 15 days for students to be reduced to 10 days.
